

What are DAY CAMPS?

Day Camps are designed to encourage children to know and be strong disciples of Jesus Christ. Through participating in the one-week program of teaching, activities and fun, children learn about God and His place in their lives.

Who SPONSORS Day Camps?

Crosstalk Ministries sponsor the Day Camps Program, an organization of ordained and lay people who are committed to spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Who is the PROGRAM For?

Day Camps are designed for children aged 4 through 12. The program includes meeting in new friends, playing games, participating in drama, dance and fine arts, singing, and learning Bible stories through plays, slide shows, and many other exciting and stimulating activities.

Who HOLDS Day Camps?

Day Camps, led by Travelling Teams of workers trained by *Crosstalk Ministries*, are held in Christian communities across Canada. In recent years we have sent out an average of 6 Travelling Teams of 2-4 members each to between 25 and 30 parishes, reaching about 1000 children per year.

Who LEADS the Day Camps?

Each Day Camp is led by a Travelling Team of workers recruited from Canada, the United States, Great Britain, and elsewhere. These teams, trained by *Crosstalk Ministries*, travel from church to church, leading the Day Camps

with the aid of local resource people and volunteers recruited by the church.

Is There ANYTHING ELSE I Can Do?

Your support of the Day Camp Program is greatly appreciated. We ask that you also keep the entire Day Camp Program, the many workers and church volunteers in your prayers. Here are some suggestions for prayer support: As you pray daily for your Partner please pray for various aspects of the whole ministry:

Friday: Pray for the Final Day of Day Camps and every child involved.

Saturday: Pray for rest and refreshment on the Day off.

Sunday: Pray for the closing services and for Travel Safety as Teams move on to new Parishes.

Prayer partners are asked to write at least two prayer letters to their Team Members(s) over the summer, encouraging them in their ministry and reminding them of your prayer support.
